- a. The term ordinarily used here will have the same meaning as Section 20 of the representation of the People Act. 1950.
- b. Where the certificates are issued by Gazetted Officers of the Union Government of State Governments, they should be in the same form but countersigned by the District Magistrate or Dy. Commissioner (Certificates issued by Gazetted officers and attested by District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner are not sufficient).
- c. The OBC certificate from the authorities only will be accepted.
